CLASS 1
9.00am



CONDITION & TURNOUT

In-hand. Any height and type of horse/pony. Tack, horse and rider should be plain/traditional. Judged on condition and turnout of horse, tack and rider.
Sunshine Tour qualifier. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 2

IN-HAND MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to all native breeds, registered and un-registered and native type horses and ponies. To be shown in natural state. Class may be split into small and large breeds if sufficient entries. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 3

SHOW HUNTER

Horses exceeding 14.2hh, not to have won £25 in Show Hunter classes. Open to riders any age. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 4

RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier

Open to all native breeds, registered and un-registered. Riders any age. Competitors will be asked to give a display not exceeding 2 minutes. Class may be split into small and large breeds if sufficient entries. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 5

SMALL & LARGE RIDING HORSE - Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier

A: Horses exceeding 14.2hh and not exceeding 15.2hh. Open to riders any age.
B: Horses exceeding 15.2hh. Open to riders any age.
Both sections will ride together and receive placings according to group. Neither horse nor rider need be affiliated to BSH or C&RH Association. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 6

SHOW COB

Open to horses and ponies of cob type. Riders any age. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 7

VETERANS – IN-HAND

Not before 2.00pm
Horses/ponies any type and height 15 years old or more. Special rosette for highest placed exhibit over 25 years old. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 8

MIXED COLOUREDS – IN-HAND

Open to any height and type of piebald, skewbald, dun, roan, palomino, spotted, etc. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 9

VETERANS – RIDDEN

Horses/ponies any type and height 15 years old or more. Special rosette for highest placed exhibit over 25 years old. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 10

MIXED COLOUREDS – RIDDEN

Open to any height and type of piebald, skewbald, dun, roan, palomino, spotted, etc. Entry fee: £9

- CLASS 17** **HAVE-A-GO / INTRODUCTION TO SHOWING - IN-HAND**
9.00am
Open to any height, type and age of horse/pony to be led by novice/new to showing handlers or experienced handlers with novice/young horses. Class includes each horse being inspected by the judge at halt, walk and trot. Horses do not need to be presented in a specialist in-hand bridle. Handlers should wear a hard hat, gloves, safe footwear. Judged on conformation, manners, action, condition and neatness of presentation. Qualifier for Sunshine Tour. Prizes kindly donated by Bookham Saddlery. Entry fee: £7
- CLASS 18** **JUNIOR HANDLER & TURNOUT**
In-hand . Small obstacle course will be laid out to help handlers show off their equine friends. Adult or big sister/brother assistance welcome! Marks also awarded for turnout, both cleanliness and presentation which can include ribbons, glitter etc. Absolutely any type of horse or pony. Handlers to be under 16 years on 1st Jan 2010. Entry fee: £7
- CLASS 19** **BEST - FIRST / BORROWED / RIDING SCHOOL / FAMILY PONY**
Open to novice riders on their first pony, borrowed, shared family or riding school pony. Ridden (may be led). Lots of rosettes! Entry fee: £7
- CLASS 20** **HANDSOMEST GELDING**
In-hand or ridden (may be led). Class may be split into ridden & led if sufficient entries. Entry fee: £7
- CLASS 21** **PRETTIEST MARE**
In-hand or ridden (may be led). Class may be split into ridden & led if sufficient entries. Entry fee: £7
- FUN IN-HAND SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIP**
In-hand or lead rein exhibitors placed 1st or 2nd in classes 17 – 21 can present themselves for the Fun Showing Championship where the overall champion and reserve champions will be awarded fabulous championship rosettes. No entry fee
- CLASS 22** **LEAD REIN RIDER**
Open to novice riders under 12 years on 1st Jan 2010. Horse/pony any height. Not required to canter or jump. Lead rein should be attached to the noseband only. Pony/ rider combinations in this class cannot enter class 23 or 24. Entry fee: £7

Any type or breed of horse/pony. Riders under 16 years on 1st Jan 2010. Will not be required to canter in a group. Each rider will have up to 2 minutes to give a freestyle show. Entry fee: £7

Open to riders under 16 years on 1st Jan 2010. Horse/pony any height. Will not be required to jump. Individual show should not exceed 2 minutes. Entry fee: £7
- CLASS 25** **JUDGE'S CHOICE**
Ridden. To be judged on usefulness and character and their appeal to the judge. Absolutely any type of horse or pony. Entry fee: £7
- FUN RIDDEN SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIP**
Ridden exhibitors placed 1st or 2nd in classes 22 – 25 & 33 can present themselves for the Fun Showing Championship where the overall champion and reserve champions will be awarded fabulous championship rosettes. No entry fee

IN-HAND EX-RACEHORSE

Open to any Weatherbys General Stud Book registered Thoroughbreds, need not have raced. Judged on conformation, straightness of action, manners, condition and neatness of presentation. Blemishes will not be penalised. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 27



HAVE-A-GO SHOWING – RIDDEN

Open to any height, type of horse/pony, 4 years old or over to be ridden by novice competitors / new to showing. Class will include horses being seen at walk and trot in a group, then each rider will have up to 2 minutes to give a freestyle show which can (but does not have to) include halt, walk, trot, canter, circles, figures of 8. The class will NOT include canter in a group or any gallop. Trot up section / judge riding - at judge's discretion on the day. Blemishes will not be penalised, plain tack and snaffle bridles are encouraged, martingales not allowed. Judged on paces, action, conformation, manners, way of going, condition and neatness of presentation. (will not start before end of Have-A-Go In-Hand class). Qualifier for Sunshine Tour. Prizes kindly donated by Bookham Saddlery. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 28

RIDDEN EX-RACEHORSE

Open to any Weatherbys General Stud Book registered Thoroughbreds, need not have raced. Judged on paces, conformation, action, manners, way of going, condition and neatness of presentation. Inclusion of trot up section / judge riding will be at the judge's discretion on the day. Blemishes will not be penalised, boots can be worn in ridden section. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 29



HAVE-A-GO WORKING HUNTER PONY Open to ponies 14.2hh and under, 4 years old or over. Martingales are allowed and bit need not be a snaffle. Section 1 - round of 1'9"-2' natural/ rustic jumps. Each competitor will go individually, boots/bandages are allowed. Section 2 - all competitors are in the ring (unless eliminated in jumping) and will show walk and trot as a group and canter individually (canter should include some extended canter), then the judge will inspect each horse. No boots/bandages (on horses!) in 2nd section. Trot up section / judge riding - judge's discretion on the day. Qualifier for Sunshine Tour. Prizes kindly donated by Bookham Saddlery. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 30

HAVE-A-GO WORKING HUNTER Open to horses exceeding 14.2hh, 4 years old or over. Jumps 2'-2'3", other class details as Have-A-Go WHP. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 31

WORKING HUNTER PONY including Mountain & Moorland WHP

A: Ponies not exceeding 13.2hh and small breed M&Ms. Fences 2' approx.
B: Ponies exceeding 13.2hh but not exceeding 14.2hh and large breed M&Ms. Fences 2'6" approx. Open to riders any age. Ponies 4 years old and over. Each section will jump then both sections return to the ring together for show judging. Entry fee: £9

CLASS 32

WORKING HUNTER - Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier & WORKING COBS

A: Cobs. Fences max. 2'9" B: Hunters exceeding 14.2hh and not exceeding 15.2hh. Fences 3'0" max. C: Hunters exceeding 15.2hh. Fences 3'3" max. .
Each section will jump then all sections return to the ring together for show judging. Open to riders any age. Mares & geldings 4 years old and over. To be judged: 60% jumping, 40% ride and conformation. Judged under SHB of GB rules. Entry fee: £9
