CLASS 1

9.00am



CONDITION & TURNOUT

In-hand. Any height and type of horse/pony. Tack, horse and rider should be plain/traditional. Judged on condition and turnout of horse, tack and rider.

Sunshine Tour qualifier.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 2

IN-HAND MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to all native breeds, registered and un-registered and native type horses and ponies. To be shown in natural state. Class may be split into small and large breeds if sufficient entries.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 3

SHOW HUNTER

Horses exceeding 14.2hh, not to have won £25 in Show Hunter classes. Open to riders any age.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 4

RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier

Open to all native breeds, registered and un-registered. Riders any age. Competitors will be asked to give a display not exceeding 2 minutes. Class may be split into small and large breeds if sufficient entries.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 5

SMALL & LARGE RIDING HORSE - Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier

A: Horses exceeding 14.2hh and not exceeding 15.2hh. Open to riders any age.

B: Horses exceeding 15.2hh. Open to riders any age.

Both sections will ride together and receive placings according to group. Neither horse nor rider need be affiliated to BSH or C&RH Association.

CLASS 6

SHOW COB

Open to horses and ponies of cob type. Riders any age

Entry fee: £8

CLASSES 7 – 11 ARE OPEN CLASSES FOR PIEBALD AND SKEWBALD HORSES & PONIES AND INCORPORATE QUALIFIERS FOR CHAPS (UK)

OPEN YOUNGSTOCK: 1, 2 or 3 year olds; no foals. CHAPS (UK) QUALIFIER

Open to any height or type of horse or pony youngstock – yearlings, 2 year olds or 3 year olds (foals excluded). N.B. 2 & 3 year old colts must be correctly bitted and shown by the appropriate age handler. See special notes for CHAPS (UK) qualification.

CLASS 8

NON-NATIVE OPEN IN-HAND – CHAPS (UK) QUALIFIER

Open to non-native type exhibits, any age, any height. To be shown plaited and trimmed. See special notes for CHAPS (UK) qualification.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 9

NATIVE/COB/TRADITIONAL OPEN IN-HAND – CHAPS (UK) QUALIFIER

Open to Native, Cob, Show Cob, Traditional, and Vanner types, any height, any age. To be shown in natural state, or fully trimmed and hogged. See special notes for CHAPS (UK) qualification.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 10

NON-NATIVE OPEN RIDDEN – CHAPS (UK) QUALIFIER.

Open to non-native type exhibits, any size of horse or pony, 4 years old or over. All exhibits to perform individual show and will not be ridden by the judge. Lead rein exhibits are not eligible for this class. To be shown plaited and trimmed. See special notes for CHAPS (UK) qualification.

Entry fee: £8

CLASS 11

NATIVE/COB/TRADITIONAL OPEN RIDDEN – CHAPS (UK) QUALIFIER.

Open to Native, Cob, Show Cob, Traditional, and Vanner type exhibits, any size horse and pony, 4 years old or over. Exhibits will be required to perform an individual show and will not be ridden by the judge. Lead Rein exhibits are not eligible for this class. To be shown in natural state or fully trimmed and hogged. See special notes for CHAPS (UK) qualification.

MINIMUS JUMPING 45-50cm / 1'6"-1'9"

Open to any absolute novice/nervous competitor and horse/pony. May be assisted but not led. Riders in this class cannot compete in classes 14 - 17. Two-phase or single phase competition. Qualifier for Sunshine Tour.

CLASS 13

ABSOLUTE NOVICE JUMPING 60cm / 2'

Open to any absolute novice/nervous competitor and horse/pony. Riders in this class cannot compete in classes 15 - 17. Two-phase or single phase competition. Qualifier for Jumping Championships of Great Britain and Sunshine Tour.

SMALL NOVICE JUMPING 65-70cm / 2'3"

Two-phase competition.

CLASS 18 JUNIOR BEST TURNOUT
9.00am Ridden, in hand or lead rein. Open to every type and height of equine friend. Handlers/riders under 14 years on 1st January 2009 (can be accompanied by adult). Turnout can include ribbons, glitter, coloured browbands, fancy saddlecloths etc. Entry fee: £6

CLASS 19 JUNIOR HANDLER
To be judged on the handler showing off their horse/pony in-hand, including at halt and a trot up. Absolutely any type of horse or pony. Handlers to be under 14 years on 1st Jan 2009. Entry fee: £6

CLASS 20 BEST - FIRST / BORROWED / RIDING SCHOOL / FAMILY PONY
Open to novice riders on their first pony, borrowed, shared family or riding school pony. Ridden (may be led). Lots of rosettes! Entry fee: £6

CLASS 21 HANDSOMEST GELDING
In-hand or ridden (may be led). Entry fee: £6

CLASS 22 PRETTIEST MARE
In-hand or ridden (may be led). Entry fee: £6

CLASS 23 LEAD REIN RIDER
Open to riders under 12 years on 1st Jan 2009. Horse/pony any height. Not required to canter or jump. Lead rein should be attached to the noseband only. Entry fee: £6

FUN IN-HAND AND LEAD REIN SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIP
Lead rein or in-hand exhibitors placed 1st or 2nd in classes 18 – 23 can present themselves for the Fun Showing Championship where the overall champion and reserve champions will be awarded fabulous championship rosettes. No entry fee

CLASS 24 BEST RIDDEN PONY
Any type or breed of pony not exceeding 14.2hh. Riders under 16 years on 1st Jan 2009. Will not be required to canter in a group. Each rider will have up to 2 minutes to give a freestyle show. Entry fee: £6

CLASS 25 BEST RIDER - JUNIOR
Open to riders under 16 years on 1st Jan 2009. Horse/pony any height. Will not be required to jump. Individual show should not exceed 2 minutes. Entry fee: £6

CLASS 26 BEST RIDER - SENIOR
Open to riders 16 years and over on 1st Jan 2009. Horse/pony any height. Will not be required to jump. Individual show should not exceed 2 minutes. Entry fee: £6

CLASS 27 JUDGE'S CHOICE
Ridden. To be judged on usefulness and character and their appeal to the judge. Absolutely any type of horse or pony. Entry fee: £6

FUN RIDDEN SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIP
Ridden exhibitors placed 1st or 2nd in classes 24 – 27 can present themselves for the Fun Showing Championship where the overall champion and reserve champions will be awarded fabulous championship rosettes. No entry fee

IN-HAND EX-RACEHORSE - Sponsored by Thoroughbred Selections
Open to any Weatherbys General Stud Book registered Thoroughbreds, need not have raced. Judged on conformation, straightness of action, manners, condition and neatness of presentation. Blemishes will not be penalised. Entry fee: £8

CLASS 29



HAVE-A-GO SHOWING – IN-HAND
Open to any height, type and age of horse/pony to be led by novice handlers / new to showing. Class will include each horse being inspected by the judge at halt, walk and trot. Horses do not need to be presented in a specialist in-hand bridle, a simple snaffle with plain/cavesson noseband with lead rein (not lunge rein) attached to bit or noseband is sufficient. All handlers should wear a hard hat, gloves and safe footwear. Judging will be on conformation, straightness of action, manners, condition and neatness of presentation. Qualifier for Sunshine Tour. Entry fee: £8

CLASS 30

RIDDEN EX-RACEHORSE - Sponsored by Thoroughbred Selections
Open to any Weatherbys General Stud Book registered Thoroughbreds, need not have raced. Judged on paces, conformation, action, manners, way of going, condition and neatness of presentation. Inclusion of trot up section / judge riding will be at the judge's discretion on the day. Blemishes will not be penalised. Entry fee: £8

CLASS 31



HAVE-A-GO SHOWING – RIDDEN
Open to any height, type of horse/pony, 4 years old or over to be ridden by novice competitors / new to showing. Class will include horses being seen at walk and trot in a group, then each rider will have up to 2 minutes to give a freestyle show which can (but does not have to) include halt, walk, trot, canter, circles, figures of 8. The class will NOT include canter in a group or any gallop. Trot up section / judge riding - at judge's discretion on the day. Blemishes will not be penalised, plain tack and snaffle bridles are encouraged, martingales not allowed. Judged on paces, action, conformation, manners, way of going, condition and neatness of presentation. Qualifier for Sunshine Tour. Entry fee: £8

CLASS 32



HAVE-A-GO WORKING HUNTER and WORKING HUNTER PONY Open to any height, type of horse/pony, 4 years old or over. Class will include: Section 1 - round of natural/ rustic jumps, for ponies 1'9"-2', for horses 2' -2'3". In this section each competitor will go individually and martingales, boots/bandages are allowed and bit need not be a snaffle. Section 2 - all competitors are in the ring (unless eliminated in jumping) and will show walk and trot as a group and canter individually (canter should include some extended canter), then the judge will inspect each horse. Trot up section / judge riding - at judge's discretion on the day. In this section tack should be as plain as possible, snaffles are encouraged and no martingales or boots/bandages (on horses!). Qualifier for Sunshine Tour. Entry fee: £8

CLASS 33

WORKING HUNTER PONY Mountain & Moorland Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier
A: Small Breed M&Ms and other ponies not exceeding 13.2hh. Fences 2' approx.
B: Large Breed M&Ms and other ponies exceeding 13.2hh but not exceeding 14.2hh. Fences 2'9" approx. Open to riders any age. Mares & geldings 4 years old and over. Each section will jump then both sections return to the ring together for show judging. To be judged: 50% jumping, 20% style of individual breed, 20% breed type & conformation, 10% individual show. Entry fee: £8

- CLASS 34** WORKING HUNTER - Balanced Horse Feeds Qualifier & WORKING COBS
A: Cobs. Fences max. 2'9" B: Hunters exceeding 14.2hh and not exceeding 15.2hh. Fences 3'0" max. C: Hunters exceeding 15.2hh. Fences 3'3" max. .
Each section will jump then all sections return to the ring together for show judging. Open to riders any age. Mares & geldings 4 years old and over. To be judged: 60% jumping, 40% ride and conformation. Judged under SHB of GB rules.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR CHAPS (UK) CLASSES

Classes 7 – 11 are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both be showing members and the horse/pony must be registered with the Society BEFORE this show for the qualification to be valid, membership cards and qualification cards must be produced in the ring, the latter being signed by the judge in 2 places. These classes are also qualifiers for Ponies UK Summer Championships, please refer to your CHAPS Handbook.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 4th, 5th & 6th September 2009. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. Ponies UK Summer Championships will be held 12th-15th August 2009. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook or visit www.chapsuk.com.

All stallions entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). ID cards must be carried in the ring for inspection. Foals born within the current year are not eligible to compete in qualifying classes.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY CLASSES

Classes 35 - 40 are Veteran Horse Society Qualifiers

No foals, spurs, galloping or wearing of earrings permitted. Minimum age handler for in-hand classes 9 yrs. The Veteran Horse Society Showing Championships Qualifiers are open to both members and non-members of the Veteran Horse Society. Please note that ONLY Veteran Horse Society members are eligible to qualify for and compete in the Regional Championship. Qualification cards will ONLY be given to the first 3 members in possession of their VHS membership / horse registration / covering letter from the VHS National Show Office. The Regional winners will go on to compete at the Veteran Horse Society Showing Supreme Championship Final at Olympia in December 2009.
