DRESSAGE EVENTS - INFORMATION

HOW TO ENTER

Pre-entry: Online at www.gb.ec.info; By post to Great Bookham Equestrian Centre, Dorking Road, Great Bookham, Surrey, KT23 4PZ.

Entry closing: Entries close on Monday prior to each competition.

Fees: Classes 1, 3, 4, 6, 7 & 8 - £16 per test; Classes 2 & 5 - £14 per test. Entries are taken in order of receipt and some classes can fill before closing date. Late entries are sometimes possible, e-mail admin@gb.ec.info for last minute availability.

Junior classes: Riders 16 years or under on 1st January 2025.

Times: Times published online www.gb.ec.info on Tuesday afternoon prior to each competition.

Judging: If insufficient entries, classes may be combined and judged on percentage.

Surfaces: Dressage classes are run on outdoor all-weather surface, warm up is in indoor or outdoor arena.

Qualifiers: All our dressage competitions are qualifiers for The Sunshine Tour Championships.
